This Pinot Noir is subtle, enticing, and shows a powerful translucent redness in the glass. Those are generally year to year attributes of this Pinot; what's different in this 2017 bottling is that it incorporates a small percentage of whole clusters, something we've never explored with this site. That was somewhat risky, as this Pinot Noir is quite earthy to begin with, and stems can be sobering to fruit expression. Nonetheless, we were curious, so we fermented a small lot with whole clusters separately.

Ultimately, we blended that tiny lot in so that this bottling features 11% whole clusters. It was slightly odd while in tank before bottling, but we really liked what the stems contributed to the mouthfeel of the wine. While the delicacy of Puerta Del Mar is exactly what we like about this Pinot, the whole clusters lent some fine tannins that integrated beautifully.

The wine has evolved beautifully during its first year in bottle. The whole cluster greenery has mellowed into a sage-y aromatic gauze, showing plenty of site-typical scents of peat, cherries, citrus and exotic spice. The palate is full of minerals, cherry and strawberry, and shows a mouthwatering thread of plum skin. It's supple and gently salty (per usual for this Pinot), then the stems enhance the spicy clench and seem to lengthen the wine a bit, too. This 2017 bottling will continue to emerge over the next couple of years, and will hit 10 years in great stride.
